

Indoor Visiting Guidelines for visiting with residents.

1. All visitors MUST PROPERLY wear a mask at ALL times while you are inside this facility. Properly means the mask fits securely and completely covers your mouth and nose.
2. All visitors MUST sign in on the provided form (s), take your temperature and sanitize hands PRIOR to your visit.
3. Visitors are NOT to walk around the facility, they are to be escorted directly to the resident's room and MUST remain in the room until the end of the visit. At the end of the visit, please use the call light to inform staff so they can escort you back to the foyer.
4. Visitors are NOT to approach other residents and visit with them.
5. If the resident has been fully vaccinated, they may have physical contact with visitors, if resident has not been fully vaccinated, visitors are NOT to have physical contact with the resident and are to practice social distancing by staying 6 feet away from resident, other residents and all staff members.
6. Only two to three visitors at each visit are allowed.

If visitors do not abide by the above guidelines, the visit will be terminated immediately and you will be asked to leave. If, during future visits, the same visitors continue to disregard the safety guidelines listed above, there is the possibility that further visits will not be scheduled for these visitors.

All visitors must sign this form before each visit.
